Economics Conference

We are planning a trip to an A Level Economics Conference on Monday 11th December 2017.

We will be meeting in central London (exact location to be confirmed) at 10.45am and leaving the venue at approximately 4.15pm. A member of staff will be at the Conference. The trip is completely voluntary. However we believe that this will be a valuable addition to your son/daughter's school experience.

The talks will focus on the UK Economy post BREXIT and will include speeches from the Rt Hon Vince Cable and Tim Harford (undercover economist for the FT and BBC presenter). These are very valuable contributions to the subject and I would recommend that all students attend. The cost of the day is £23.50 plus travel expenses.
