Home School Agreement

This agreement outlines the responsibilities and expectations of all concerned with the child's development. It supports the ethos, aims and mission statement of the School which are outlined in the School Prospectus. The School works closely with our Safer School's Police Officer to ensure a safe environment for all concerned.

The Family will endeavour to:

- support the Christian values of the school community
- ensure that their child goes to school regularly, on time and correctly dressed and equipped for a day's work at school. The attendance target for each child is 95%.
- make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour
- support the school's policies and guidelines on behaviour, including detentions support their child in homework and other opportunities for home-learning
- attend parents'/carers' evenings and discussions about their child's progress
- get to know about their child's life at the school
- refrain from taking their child on holiday during term time

The School will endeavour to:

- provide a secure, happy and stimulating learning environment within a Christian ethos
- care for your child's safety and well being
- ensure that your child achieves his/her full potential as a valued member of the school community
- provide a balanced curriculum and meet the individual needs of your child
- achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility
- ensure that school policies are applied fairly and consistently
- keep you informed about general school matters and about your child's progress in particular
- be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of the school
- regularly set and assess your child's work

- respect the Christian ethos of the school through participating in assemblies and worship and by valuing the contribution of all members of the school community
- attend school and lessons regularly and punctually
- bring all the equipment needed every day
- wear the school uniform correctly and be tidy in appearance
- do all classwork and homework as well as possible and copy up any work missed
- be polite and helpful to others
- keep the school free from litter and graffiti
- follow the school's Behaviour Policy and behave in a responsible and safe manner when travelling to and from school and when involved in extracurricular activities contribute to the work of the School Council through discussing issues raised
