Year 11 Revision Sessions

This letter is to inform you about revision sessions that are taking place before the end of this term. This will take some students out of lessons, but we have identified this last week of term as being key in setting students on the right course for further revision over the Easter holidays and believe this programme to be a good use of time.

On Wednesday 2nd April all students will be involved in a 2 hour revision skills workshop delivered by 'Positively M.A.D.', a company specialising in delivering high quality skills sessions to GCSE students. For students in the X half of the Year Group this will be during Periods 1 and 2 and for students in the Y half of the Year Group this will be during Periods 4 and 5.

On Thursday 3rd April, there will be a revision day for identified students on the C/D borderline in Science, run by Twenty-Twenty Learning.

On Friday 4th April, there will be a number of sessions delivered for identified students. This is actually a Staff INSET Day, but we are taking the opportunity to use this to deliver some important sessions to students, and would value your support in ensuring that wherever possible students attend the sessions to which they are invited. The sessions running are:
