Oyster Card Changes

You may already be aware that there are some changes to the Oyster card system which may affect your child. We just wanted to be sure that all potential users were fully informed – the information from TfL is as follows:-

TfL Update re the Oyster System

As from **6th July** London's buses will **no longer accept cash** so all students will need an Oyster card. Students who rely on the Oyster Card System to travel by bus must make appropriate arrangements if their Oyster Card is lost or stolen. If their card is lost or stolen they will need to order a replacement card.

But how do they travel in the days between the loss and the replacement arriving?

It is suggested by TfL that for families where the bus is their only way of getting to school, that they need to have a reserve/back up adult card at home.

Any person can use an adult card. If a student uses the adult card then the adult bus fare will be deducted from the card but travel will be allowed.
