**Theatre Trip to see 'The Commitments'**

This year we will be going to see 'The Commitments' on Wednesday 21st January 2015.

We will be leaving school at 5.00pm which will leave sufficient time to get to the Theatre should there be any traffic problems. We will be returning to the Highgrove car park drop off point by 11.00pm.

For safety reasons, we would strongly request that as the coaches will need to park it is essential that you do not stop or park your vehicle in or around the drop off area when collecting your son/daughter. Naturally, should this area be congested, coaches will be unable to gain access and stop safely allowing the safe delivery of your son/daughter.

Please note, your son/daughter will be expected to attend school the following morning for registration, at 8.40am.
