### **Cross Curricular Sixth Form Trip: Business and Economics – Prague, April 2018**

Bishop Ramsey are very pleased to be able to offer your son/daughter the opportunity to take part in a 3 day trip to Prague in the Czech Republic. This trip will take place in the Easter break from **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> April to Friday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2018**. The trip offered through the NST Travel Group, is designed to enrich the Business and Economics curriculum and is also open to students studying other subjects in the Sixth Form.

The students will visit sites to learn about the production and operations of firms, an area of operation which is difficult to provide trips for in the UK and which benefits from practical experience. The visit and activities include a Skoda factory and museum, the Ruckl Glass factory, the Staropramen brewery and an Economics lecture from the world famous Cerge Institute. We will also experience a city tour and riverboat excursion. This trip has been designed not only to enrich your son/daughter's educational curriculum but provide a valuable and life-changing experience for them.

The cost of the trip will be no more than **£390** (the final price and the viability of the trip going ahead is dependent on minimum numbers being reached). The price includes local coach hire, air travel, all internal travel, accommodation at the Hotel Pivovar (housed in the former Vysocany Brewery building) all entrance fees and tours, as well as breakfast while in Prague and two dinners. We hope to, in the final price, arrange for a coach for the return journey from the Airport (Stansted). Students will require some spending money for lunches and snacks.

To secure a place on this trip, a non-refundable deposit of **£100** should be paid via ParentPay by **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2017**. Please select '**Prague 2018**'. This trip has limited availability and places will be allocated on a first come first served basis, based on payment of the deposit.
