### Year 10 Compulsory Geography GCSE Field Trip

As part of your son/daughter's GCSE Geography course it is a requirement that they gather primary data for the topics 'The UK's evolving physical landscape' and 'The UK's evolving human landscape'.

In order to successfully complete the research needed, we have arranged a two night stay at the Fieldwork study centre at Castle Head Field Centre, Grange-over-sands, Cumbria. We will be leaving early on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> June at 7.00am and return on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> June at approximately 6.00pm. The three day visit will give your son/daughter the opportunity to learn new skills and collect data which they will analyse in subsequent lessons. This is worth 15% of their qualification.

It is essential that students attend the trip in order to be successful in their summer 2019 exam.

The cost of the trip will be £250 which includes travel, 2 nights' accommodation, food and full tuition programme from field study specialist tutors at the Fieldwork Centre.

The payment can be paid over 2 instalments. A non-refundable deposit of £50 is due on **Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> March**, followed by a final payment of £200 by **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2018**. Payments can be made via Parent Pay and selecting '**Geography Field Trip – Cumbria 2017/2018**'. Please also complete and return the attached reply slip to me by Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> March.

Your son/daughter will need to bring a pack lunch with them for the journey on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> June. An equipment list will be forwarded at a later date. Students should bring with them any required medication; asthma inhalers, epipens, etc. Mobile phones and any other items of value can be taken but students do so at their own risk.

All students who travel as part of a group represent Bishop Ramsey School, therefore the highest standards of behaviour and conduct are expected as a matter of course.
