Dear Parent/Carer,

Enrichment Days Thursday 12th and Friday 13th July 2018

As part of the school's Enrichment Days on 12th and 13th July, Year 7 students will be visiting both the Natural History Museum and Science Museum. All students will attend each museum in a teacher guided exploration of History and Science, as well as planned activities at each museum. The Year group will be split into two groups with half of the Year group attending each museum on both days.

I can confirm that your son/daughter will be attending each museum on the following days:

Natural History Museum

12th July – Rocks the House Show – Students will discover how tectonic plate interactions shape landscapes, generate earthquakes and form volcanoes.

Science Museum

13th July – Wonderlab – Inspired by power of wondering, *Wonderlab: The Statioil Gallery* enriches learning across the curriculum themes of Forces, Electricity, Light, Sound, Matter, Space and Maths.

Due to a high demand for one particular activity, I am aware that some students have not been given their first choice of activity. Students have been assigned an activity based on a first come first served basis.

On both 12th and 13th July students will meet at school for **8:45am**. Both groups of students will then travel with their group leaders to Ruislip Manor Station where we will catch a Piccadilly Line service to South Kensington Station. We are hoping to secure free travel through Transport for London. However I suggest students bring their ZIP Oyster Card with adequate funds just in case we are unable to do this. From here students will travel to either the Natural History or Science Museum. Students are permitted to wear appropriate non-uniform for these two days. They will need a packed lunch for both trips. All students will be required to wear their lanyards on both Thursday and Friday. We aim to arrive back at school between 3:15pm and 3:45pm.

Students should bring with them any required medication; asthma inhalers, epipens, etc. Mobile phones and any other items of value can be taken but students do so at their own risk.
