### Humanities trip to Naples and the Amalfi Coast – Easter 2019

The Humanities Faculty are delighted to offer your son/daughter the fantastic opportunity to visit Naples and the Amalfi Coast next year during the Easter holidays (6<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> April 2019). This is a voluntary trip designed to offer your son/daughter an enriching experience to learn about the culture, history and environment of the region.

This trip is open to all students in Years 10-13 studying a Humanities subject (History or Geography and in the Sixth Form Government and Politics). The approximate cost per student will be £900 (please note the final cost is subject to flight prices and will be confirmed later in September).

The trip will include:

- ✓ Direct flights to Naples
- ✓ Accommodation in Sorrento for the duration of the stay
- ✓ Breakfast and most meals
- ✓ Excursions including guides and transport as appropriate.

The main highlights of the trip are as follows:

- Guided tours of the ancient sites of Pompeii and Herculaneum
- Visit and tour of Vesuvius
- Highlights of the Amalfi coast
- Day trip to the island of Capri including a visit to the famous Blue Grotto
- Highlights of Naples including an underground tour of the city
- Visit to the Phlegraen Fields.

There are a **small number of places remaining** for this trip and we envisage high demand so to secure a place for your son/daughter a non-refundable deposit of **£300** should be paid via ParentPay by **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2018**. Please log onto ParentPay and select '**Naples and the Amalfi Coast – Easter 2019**'. Should maximum numbers be reached prior to 20<sup>th</sup> September, ParentPay will close for this item.
