A Level Economics Conference

We are planning a trip to an A Level Economics Conference on Monday 26 November 2018. The conference will focus on the UK Economy post BREXIT and will include speeches from the Rt Hon John McDonald, Rt Hon Sir Keir Starmer and Kamal Ahmed (BBC presenter.)

We will meet in central London (exact location to be confirmed) by 10:45am and will be leaving at approximately 4:15pm. A member of staff will be at the Conference. The trip is completely voluntary. However we believe that this will be a valuable addition to your child's school experience and understanding of the subject. I would recommend that all students attend.

The cost of the event is **£24.50**. Students will also need their oyster card with sufficient funds to facilitate the journey.
