#### Year 9 Religious Education Trip to St Pauls

We are pleased to inform you that your son/daughter has been chosen to join a trip which is being run by the Religious Education Faculty, as a reward for their hard work in Religious Education. 30 Year 9 students will visit St. Paul's Cathedral on Friday 9th November 2018

We will be leaving school at 8.45am and returning at approximately 4.00pm. Students will travel to and from the venue using London Underground accompanied by three of their teachers. Please ensure that your son/daughter has an oyster card with sufficient funds for a single tube journey or that they have cash to purchase a single ticket. The return journey will be outside of peak hours and so we are able to apply for free travel for this.

As this is a reward trip, it is being paid for by the Religious Education Faculty so there will be no cost other than travel. Students are expected to dress in full school uniform, which reflects the nature of the visit, and bring a packed lunch.

Students should also bring with them any required medication: asthma inhalers, epipens, etc. Mobile phones and any other items of value can be taken, but students do so at their own risk.

All students who travel as part of a group represent Bishop Ramsey School. Therefore the highest standards of behaviour and conduct are expected as a matter of course.
