Visit to Malosa Secondary School – Malawi July 2019

Thank you for your interest in the visit to Malosa school, Malawi. I can confirm that we have received your deposit and your place is secured. The flights have been booked with Kenya Airways as follows:

We depart on 27th June and return on 11th July 2019. We aim to stay at Mua Mission on the first night where students will learn about the tribal culture of Malawi. We will travel to Malosa where we will stay at Chilema Ecumenical Centre and visit Malosa Secondary School where we will interact with students. Finally we will move to Mvuu Lodge in the Liwonde National Park for boat, jeep and walking safaris.

We will make time to visit some local areas of natural beauty and interest – in particular Lake Malawi - as well as visiting local villages. The links below should give you a flavour of what to expect:

Please provide a copy of your son/daughters passport. It will need to be valid for 6 months after the return date so please check the expiry date. Please bring this copy in over the next 2 weeks to Mrs Holmes in the Sixth Form Office.

Vaccinations and anti-malarials are needed for this region. It is recommended that you visit the travel nurse at your GP's surgery and they will advise you according to your personal medical history. We have traditionally taken Malarone for anti-malarial protection – students have found that it has no real side effects, unlike some other products on the market, but please discuss this with your medical advisor. You should not need Yellow Fever vaccinations as we are only transiting through Nairobi, Kenya.

£200 deposit already paid


£1060 by Wednesday 3rd April 2019 (this can be paid in full or by instalments)
