### Local Food Competition

Your daughter has been selected to represent Bishop Ramsey School at a local food competition on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June at Belazu (a local food manufacturer) in Greenford, West London. We will leave school at 12:45pm and are due to return by 4.00pm where students will be dismissed to make their own way home. We will travel by school mini bus.

Student will be required to present a PowerPoint presentation and their food product to a panel of judges from Belazu and in front of a small number of teams from other schools. There is no cost for participating in this event.

Students will be required to wear full school uniform and bring a packed lunch. Students should also bring with them any required medication; asthma inhalers, epipens, etc. Mobile phones and any other items of value can be taken but students do so at their own risk. All students who travel as part of a group represent Bishop Ramsey School, therefore the highest standards of behaviour and conduct are expected as a matter of course.
