**Tate Modern – Olafur Eliasson Trip – Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2019**

I am writing to let you know that I will be leading a trip to the Tate Modern Gallery to see the Olafur Eliasson exhibition on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> October. This is an excellent opportunity for students to see the work of an internationally renowned artist who works in a variety of media and techniques. There will be a small fee of **£5.00** to the exhibition. **Students will need to pay for this individually on the Tate website under the Tate Collective scheme.** This will allow them to book future exhibitions at all four of the Tate galleries for a discounted rate of £5.00.

We will travel to the Tate as a group on London Underground, leaving school at 12.30pm. Students will have approximately one hour to look around the exhibition. Students will be dismissed at 3.15pm to make their own way home. However, they will then have the opportunity to look around the gallery where they could sketch and gain inspiration for their coursework.

As we are leaving school during lunch hour students will need to bring along snacks for the journey. Please ensure that your son/daughter has sufficient funds on their oyster card to facilitate the journey. Students are also advised to bring along their sketchbooks and dry drawing materials as well as money to spend on postcards in the Tate Bookshop.

Please note that upon emailing your consent you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions associated with this trip:

- To be given a mild painkiller (eg. Paracetamol) if considered necessary by the party leader.
- To received medical treatment in an emergency situation if as parent/carer you cannot be contacted
- To make their own way home from the venue.

You confirm:

- That your son/daughter's medical details are correct on the Parent Portal and will inform us of any changes to these details between now and the trip
- That you understand that if your son/daughter's behaviour in school is not acceptable then he/she may be withdrawn from the trip.
