A Level Physical Education Trip – Body Worlds

I am pleased to offer your son/daughter a place on the A Level Physical Education trip to the Body Worlds Expo in London (Piccadilly) on Tuesday 11th February 2020.

Body Worlds London is an educational museum that exhibits preserved human bodies through the process of plastination. It is designed to educate about the inner workings of the human body and shows the effects that daily lifestyle choices have on our health. It supports the various different aspects of the A Level P.E. course, especially the anatomy and physiology/exercise physiology section. There are over 200 exhibits spread over 6 galleries including: Reproductive System, Respiratory System, Digestive System, Locomotive System, Nervous System and the Cardiovascular System. All of these systems students on the P.E. course need to know in great detail. We hope that this trip will help them gain a deeper understanding and interest in this area of study.

We are booked in to begin our tour at 10.30am. It is recommended to spend around 2.5 hours in the exhibition, although we may spend longer. Students are to meet staff at Ruislip Manor station at 8.40am, for us to get the tube to Piccadilly Circus. Students will need to ensure that they have sufficient funds on their oyster card to facilitate the journey.

Students will be supervised by both myself and Mr Rhodes throughout the trip. Students will need to bring a packed lunch/some money to get lunch after the event where we will have some time to discuss the exhibition. We will then travel back to Ruislip Manor. If students wish to leave the train earlier or travel further on to make their way home, please email your consent to ccurling@bishopramsey.school and also indicate which station they will be alighting from. We are due to arrive back at Ruislip Manor at approximately 3.00pm.

The cost of this trip is £18.50. This will cover the entry ticket to the exhibition. Payment should be made via ParentPay and selecting '**Body Worlds – 2019/20**'. Payment should be received by Friday 31st January. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept payments after this date. You confirm:


- That your son/daughter's medical details are correct on the Parent Portal and will inform us of any changes to these details between now and the trip
