### Year 11

I hope that this evening's Parent's Consultation Evening will prove to be very helpful in finding out how your son/daughter is progressing in their studies, and will give advice regarding the next steps in preparation for the GCSE exams. The Year 11 report, which will be issued at the end of March, will give an update on further progress.

There are a number of relevant issues that I want to bring to your attention via this letter.

All students will be having a 'Post-16 Interview' during the next few weeks. These are 10 minute interviews that take place with the Sixth Form team or Miss Priestley, where Sixth Form option choices, or other plans for students who are not intending to remain at Bishop Ramsey, are discussed. Form Tutors will inform students of the times of these.

A date has now been agreed for the Year 11 Prom – **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2020**. If last year's Prom is anything to go by, the event is set to be a fantastic and memorable way for students to celebrate their time at Bishop Ramsey with their peers and with their teachers. As always the Prom will be a formal event, held in the school Hub, starting at 7.00pm. Parents are most welcome to attend to watch and take photos of the students arriving. The event will finish at 10:00pm.

To further commemorate your son/daughters time at Bishop Ramsey we are now beginning the process of creating a fantastic Leavers' Yearbook full of photographs and memories which will be available for all students to purchase. Further details about this will follow in due course.

Attendance at the Prom is a privilege not a right. As in previous years, this means that we will be monitoring student behaviour and attendance very carefully in the coming months and any student who seriously or persistently breaches the school rules will lose the privilege of attending the Prom. A Fixed Term Exclusion will automatically result in the student being unable to attend the Prom. If a student is issued with an Internal Exclusion, is removed from a lesson, truants a lesson/assembly or fails to attend two detentions they will be issued with a Prom Warning. We do not take these decisions lightly, but it is important that the students are focused during lessons and taking advantage of every opportunity to prepare for the GCSE examinations, and that you are aware of our expectations.
