### Year 9 Curriculum Day 2020

A date for your diaries. On Thursday **2<sup>nd</sup> April 2020**, the Year 9 timetable will be collapsed for the day to allow the students to participate in our 'Curriculum Day'. The traditional curriculum gives students the opportunity to develop knowledge and skills that help them to prepare for the next stage in their academic careers, as stated in the 'Learning' aspect of our curriculum intent. This Curriculum Day has been designed to allow students to practise skills that will prepare them for future life (Loving and Living aspects of our curriculum intent), such as team work, problem solving and understanding their own and others' cultures.

The day will run on a rotation basis, involving all students having the opportunity to understand more about their local community, by visiting Ruislip Castle, as well as about the global community through workshops on cultures from around the world. Finally, they will be involved in a team building/group work/problem solving scenario, through a STEM or Food Technology project.

The day will start at 8.40am as usual with students registering with their Form Tutors. They will then move to their first activity and rotate throughout the day as directed by staff.

Students will be expected to wear full school uniform as usual. Lunch will be slightly earlier at 12.05pm with the day finishing at 3.15pm as usual. There will be no cost to parents/carers for the day.

The visit to Ruislip Castle will require students to walk to the site in Ruislip, from school (approximately 15 minute walk) and back again. Please ensure they have waterproof clothing/coats if the weather is inclement. They will be supervised by staff at all times.
