Computer Science Sixth Form Trip to Breakin' Escape Rooms, London

The ICT and Computing Faculty are pleased to offer your son/daughter the opportunity to participate in an Escape Room experience at Breakin' Escape Rooms London, 89 Holloway Road, London N7 8LT on **Monday 23rd March**. Students will travel independently to and from the venue using public transport. We will meet at 11.30am outside the Escape Room, ready to enter at 12.00pm.

This event is a good opportunity for students to practice their problem solving skills in a highly engaging event driven environment. Escape Rooms involve groups of individuals entering a room which is full of puzzles and riddles that must be solved within 60 minutes in order to 'escape'. Groups who do not solve all problems within the hour are still released anyway but are left without the same sense of achievement. It is a good idea for students to bring a packed lunch with them or bring money to buy lunch afterwards. The event is likely to end at approximately 1.15pm, at which point students will be dismissed to make their own way home.

Whilst there is no dress code it is recommended that students wear comfortable informal clothing as some of the activities involve physical activity. Students should bring with them any required medication; asthma inhalers, or epipens, etc. The four Escape Rooms booked may contain strobe lighting so students should make their teacher aware if this is likely to impact on their health. Please note that mobile phones and any other items of value can be taken but students do so at their own risk. There are lockers available onsite for any valuables that students do not want to take into the Escape Room.

The trip/visit is completely voluntary but will offer valuable enrichment of the curriculum.

The cost of this trip is **£18.50**. Payment should be made via ParentPay and selection '**Escape Room – 2019/20**'. Payment should be received by Monday 19th March 2020. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept payments after this date.
