

Core Learning Tutors

The job

The role of Core Learning Tutor involves the one-to-one tutoring of students at KS3 and KS4 in KS4 student in English, Maths, Science and/or general revision support. This will involve delivering support to an assigned student after school. You will be given some resources and training but will need to plan the sessions and liaise with relevant subject staff.

Before taking up the post you will be expected to attend training delivered by the school to support you in this new role.

What we are looking for:

- ✓ Students who have compassion for students with learning needs and those with Pupil Premium status.
- ✓ Great role models that are enthusiastic and encouraging.
- ✓ People with a passion for education.
- ✓ Students who will inspire and motivate young people.
- ✓ You'll have a grade 6 or above in the subject you wish to tutor (English/Maths/Science).
- ✓ You might have some experience working with children and you'll definitely have the desire to meaningfully impact a child's education and be an aspirational role model for our students.

Expectations & pay

- You will be delivering sessions one-to-one.
- You will be expected to plan for the session. This will be paid on the basis of one planning hour for every two hours you deliver.
- The pay for this role is on the basis of £10 per hour (payment will be made upon receipt of a duly authorised timesheet and you will be paid £10 per hour on the basis of 1 ½ hours pay per session delivered).
- You will be paid in term time only and when the tutee is present.
- You are not paid for training.

The application
