Rapid Lateral Flow Testing Kits

I am writing to inform you that a further supply of testing kits will be issued to students in Years 7 – 11 next Tuesday 12th October.

Testing kits for students in Years 12 and 13 will be available for students to collect from Tuesday 12th October, from the Sixth Form Office.

For ease, please find below a suggested LFT testing schedule allowing for two tests to be completed each week:
