**Year 12 Curriculum Day – Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2022**

We are finalising our plans for the Year 12 Curriculum Day trip to the Clink Prison Museum and St Katharine's Dock as mentioned in my letter dated 16<sup>th</sup> December. This enriching experience will allow students to learn more about London's history and different approaches to crime and punishment.

The confirmed cost of this trip is £6 per student. Please note that upon making your payment you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions associated with this trip:

Your permission is granted for your son/daughter:

- To attend the trip
- To be given a mild painkiller (eg. Paracetamol) if considered necessary by the party leader.
- To received medical treatment in an emergency situation if as parent/carer you cannot be contacted.

You confirm:

- That your son/daughter's medical details are correct on Arbor and will inform us of any changes to these details between now and the trip
- That you understand that if your son/daughter's behaviour in school is not acceptable then he/she may be withdrawn from the trip and any monies paid to date will not be refunded.

Students will make their way independently to east London. We will meet as a group outside London Bridge Underground station (Northern and Jubilee Lines) at **10.00am** and make our way to the Clink Museum. From here students will complete a self-guided tour of the museum before embarking in staggered groups on an independent walking tour of St. Katharine's dockyard (approx. 1 mile from the Clink Museum). Once completed students will then make their own way home. The nearest station to this area is Tower Hill (Circle and District lines). Depending on how long students spend on their tour of St Katharine's Dock, they are likely to arrive home at approximately 4.00-5.00pm.

Please ensure that your son/daughter has their Oyster card with sufficient funds to facilitate the journey.
