Dear Parent/Carer,

Champing in Oxford –Years 10 to 13

The Chaplaincy are offering the opportunity to go Champing (camping in a church) in Oxford from Friday 17th Saturday 18th March 2023.

The trip will include some exploration of the hidden gems of Oxford, as well as some worship and teaching sessions led by the Chaplaincy Team and some free time in town. The trip is completely voluntary however we believe that this will be a valuable addition to your child's school experience. There is a limit of 45 places on this trip. Should we have more applicants than spaces, these names will be placed on a waiting list.

The total cost of this trip per student is £60.00 including coach, dinner and breakfast costs. Students in Years 10 – 11 who are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding will have this cost covered.

Your child will also need sufficient funds to buy lunch on Saturday, during free time in Oxford.

It is anticipated that there will be a high level of interest, but places are limited and therefore will be allocated on a strict first come first served basis on completion of this [form](#). The form will become active at **7.00pm** on Thursday 9th February.

Successful applicants will be notified on Thursday 23rd February, at which time payment and consent details will be provided. Students on the waiting list will also be notified at the same time.

We will travel to the venue by coach, from school, at 3.00pm on Friday 17th March. Students would need to be collected from school on Saturday, 18th March at 6.30pm.

It is the school's view that trips are a privilege reserved for students who meet the requirements of the school's Behaviour Policy. Students, who fail to meet these requirements, as decided by the Headteacher, may be refused permission to participate in a school trip. Should a student be excluded from a trip, any monies paid to that date will not be refunded.
