Year 10 English Trip - Charles Dickens Museum

As part of Bishop Ramsey's Lit Fest, we are pleased to invite your child to take part trip to the Charles Dickens Museum on **Friday 3rd March 2023**.

Students will have the opportunity for a guided tour of the museum at 48 Doughty Street, the former home of Charles Dickens. They will take part in a 'Ghosts' workshop where students will work collaboratively using inference and applying literary and problem-solving skills to complete a series of challenges. This session looks closely at 'A Christmas Carol' whilst also providing strong contextual information about Victorian life and supernatural beliefs.

There is no cost for this workshop.

We will be travelling by tube to Russell Square, leaving school at 8.45am and returning to school at approximately 2.00pm, where students will join their Period 5 lesson of the day. Students will need their Oyster card, with sufficient funds, for the outward journey. We will have a group travel card for the return journey.

Students should wear full school uniform and should bring a packed lunch and drink. We recommend that students also bring a notebook and pen to take notes from the workshop. There is a small gift shop at the museum so students may like to bring some spending money.

Students should bring with them any required medication; asthma inhalers, epipens, etc. Mobile phones and any other items of value can be brought but students do so at their own risk and they will be expected to turn them off during the event.
